#### The Paper Bag

- The "The Paper Bag" platform was founded in 2017 by the leading European kraft paper manufacturers and producers of paper bags.
- Its purpose is to represent the interests of the European paper bag industry and to promote the advantages of paper packaging on a European level.
- Its special focus is on raising awareness of the environmental credentials of paper carrier bags and supporting retailers in their packaging decisions to foster a bio-based economy.

#### **Achievements**

- The publication *The Green Book* explains a great number of aspects about paper bags from quality standards to EU legislation, branding and sustainability issues. It includes different research results, infographics and reports, and is available in English, Swedish, French and Italian.
- In 2018, the platform has initiated the "European Paper Bag Day" to raise awareness among consumers about paper bags as the packaging of the future.
